Central Agricultural University, Imphal having constituent colleges in six states of North Eastern Hill Region bagged 2nd position amongst the 65 Agricultural Universities in India by securing Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) on the basis of Common Entrance Examination conducted by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR).

Dr. S. N. Puri, Vice-Chancellor, Central Agricultural University Imphal received the award from Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on the occasion of celebration of 86th Foundation Day of ICAR on July 29, 2014 in presence of Hon'ble Union Minister for Agriculture & Food Processing Industries, Shri Radha Mohan Singh & Hon'ble Minister of State for Agriculture & Food Processing Industries, Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Balyan. Total 33 students from CAU secured JRF and 117 students have been admitted to different PG courses in various National Institutes & State Agricultural Universities (SAUs).



This is the **second time** that the university has been awarded for its student's performance at National level. In 2012 Central Agricultural University, Imphal had been conferred the award from ICAR for attaining 2nd position among all the SAU's in India.

The College of Fisheries, Tripura, a constituent College of Central Agricultural University. Out of total 21 numbers of Junior Research Fellowship available for B. F. Sc. students from all over India, Five (5) were awarded to students of this College for their excellence in all India entrance examination (AIEEA-PG-2014) conducted by ICAR, New Delhi. Ten (10) students got admitted to the National University, CIFE, and Mumbai with Institutional fellowship. In last academic year 2012-13, seven (7) students got JRF and 17 got admitted in CIFE Mumbai through all India entrance examination (AIEEA-PG-2013). The students of this college were all India toppers under all categories i.e. General, OBC, UPS, SC and ST, in AIEEA-PG-2013 examination.

The passed out students of this College have also shown good performance in Agricultural Research Service Examination conducted by Agricultural Scientist Recruitment Board(ASRB), ICAR, New Delhi. A total of fifteen (15) students have joined as **scientists** during 2013 and twelve (12) students have been selected as **scientists** in 2014.
