

Mass Fruit Tree Plantation Programme

Agartala Tripura 06 December 2019: Under Mission Green India, the national call was given by hon'ble Prime Minister of the country Shri Narendra for mass tree plantation in the country. The aim of the programme is to protect, restore and enhance India's diminishing forest cover and respond to climate change. Further to create awareness among the people about importance trees and environment. Today, Shri Ratan Lal Nath, Honourable Minister of Education (Higher/School), Law(including Parliamentary Affairs), Welfare of Others Backward Communities and Welfare of minorities, inaugurated mass fruit plantation programme in Koraitala village of Dakshin Taranagar, Mohanpur, Tripura in the presence of Dr. Pramod Kumar Pandey, Dean, College of Fisheries, Central Agricultural University, Lembucherra, Tripura. The programme was organized by the College of Fisheries, Central Agricultural University under initiative of development of Fruit Plant Model Villages in Tripura and other states of North East. The college staff and students also the residents of Koraitala and nearby villages more than two hundred fifty people were participated in this Mass plantation programme. Along with plantation, cleanliness campaign with collection of polythene and paper wastes were also undertaken by the participants. A total of 400 saplings of Amrapali variety of Mango along with Areca nut were planted in the Koraitala para of Dakshin Taranagar GP, Mohanpur subdivision, West Tripura.
