

Report of the mass plantation programme “Grow plants, grow with plants”

As a new initiative towards creating a sense of social responsibility among the students to make the surroundings green and a safe place for future generation, the College of Fisheries, CAU (I), Tripura organized a mass plantation programme “Grow plants, grow with plants” on 23rd August 2017 at the premises of the college. At the very outset, Dr. S. Khogen Singh, SWO & co-ordinator of the programme highlighted an outline of the programme. Further, Dr. Pramod Kumar Pandey, Dean, College of Fisheries, CAU (I) addressed the gathering about the importance of plants in our life and ignited the mass, specially the students about students’ role in creating a green campus. Dr. Naresh Kr. Mehta, Asst. Professor and co-cordinator of the programme arranged the saplings and other plantation requirement for the said programme.

Dr. Pramod Kumar Pandey, Dean, College of Fisheries, CAU (I) along with Dr. R.K. Saha, Professor and Head, Dept. of Aquatic Health and Environment initiated the plantation of the sapling followed by 40 B.F.Sc. 1st year students and other faculty & staff members present. The major highlight of the programme is that the B.F.Sc. 1st year students shall take responsibility of nurturing the individual plant till the time they graduate from the college and on successful completion of their degree, they shall be awarded with a “Green Certificate” containing the photographs of particular students with the plants to encourage them and create a sense of social responsibility. Fifty plant saplings of Lemon and Litchi were planted during the programme.
