

## Report on the celebration of “Samagra Swachhta Diwas” on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2017 at the College of Fisheries, CAU (I), Lembucherra, Tripura

The College of Fisheries, CAU (I), Lembucherra, Tripura celebrated the “**Samagra Swachhta Diwas**” under the campaign of “Swachhata Hi Sewa” on 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 to mark the anniversary of Swachha Bharat Mission. At the very outset, faculty, staff members, students and scholars of the college had a mass gathering at the college main gate. Dr. Pramod Kumar Pandey, Dean, College of Fisheries, CAU (I) addressed the participants and emphasized the need of such programme on regular basis to have a clean environment in and outside the campus. To commemorate the occasion, the participants took a stand to clean one of the nearby villages, Bagbari village, Mohanpur Block (2 kms from campus), which is also the adopted village under the college Village Adoption Programme.
